Dear Parents

We are currently working on our school structure for September 2025. The class and year group structures we currently have will stay the same for the next academic year. This means that:-

Beech Class – Reception children and year 1 (Year 1 registration only)

Oak Class – Year 1 and 2

Maple Class – Year 3 and 4

Ash Class – Year 4 and 5

Cedar – Year 6

If your child is currently in Reception then they will either be registered in Beech class or Oak class and their registration teachers will either be Mrs McKee/ Mrs Enticknap or Mrs Blackwood respectively.

If your child is currently in Year 1 then your children will be in Oak class and their teacher will be Mrs Blackwood.

If your child is currently in Year 2 they will all be in Maple class and their teacher will be Mrs Westbrook.

If your child is currently in Year 3 then they will either be in Maple class Ash Class and their teachers will be Mrs Westbrook and Mrs Murphy respectively.

If your child is currently in Year 4 then your children will be in Ash class and their teacher will be Mrs Murphy.

If your child is currently in Year 5 then they will be in Cedar Class and their teacher will be Mr Russell.

The first transition morning will be on Wednesday 2nd July. Our year 6 children will be at their secondary school transition days. The year 4 and 5 children will be at Cobnor, and because we don't have a full school on Wednesday, the morning will look a little different to our normal transition day for the new year 1 and year 4 .

The new year 4 children will all spend the morning with Mrs Phillips. The new year 1 children will all spend the morning with Mrs Blackwood.

Our second transition morning will be on Tuesday 8th July when all children in years R-5 will move to their next year groups for the morning. Registration will be as normal and children will move after assembly.
