**QUIZ NIGHT** - Saturday 8th March

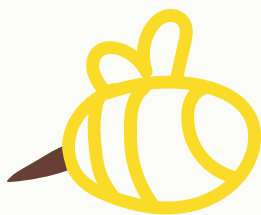
